

COUNCIL DECISION

of 9 April 1968

amending the Rules of the Advisory Committee on Vocational Training

(68/189/EEC)

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 128 thereof;

Having regard to the Council Decision of 2 April 1963¹ laying down general principles for implementing a common vocational training policy, and in particular the last subparagraph of the fourth principle thereof;

Having regard to the Rules of the Advisory Committee on Vocational Training², and in particular Article 5 thereof;

Whereas experience has shown the harmful consequences of interruption of the work of the Committee on Vocational Training resulting from any delay between the expiry and the renewal of the term of office of its members;

After Having obtained the Opinion of the Commission which, for this purpose, consulted the Advisory Committee on Vocational Training;

Sole Article

The following shall be substituted for the provisions of Article 5 of the Rules of the Advisory Committee on Vocational Training:

'The term of office for members and alternates shall be two years. Their appointments may be renewed.

After expiry of their term of office, members and alternates shall remain in office until they are replaced or until their appointments are renewed.'
